Sub group decisions and actions

Decisions

1. All Partners should review outputs – reporting on progress to the steering group in June
2. The output review should follow the matrix designed by the Scottish Waterways Trust (TSWT)
3. The Resource centre will be a “Virtual” Resource centre – it can be stand-alone but will be linked to the G&BF website
4. TSWT will engage a consultant to write a brief for the monitoring and evaluation of pilot actions, methodology of outcome measurements and outputs set out in WP 4

TSWT will ask each partner for details of companies or organisations that may wish to have the opportunity to tender for this work

Actions

Transnational exchanges

1. Hainaut will contact Scottish Canals and arrange a tour of the social enterprises set up with in the Helix Project

2. TSWT to invite South Tipperary to review outputs from Canal College successes and to have a guided project tour with Managers , tutors , mentors and volunteers
3. Hainaut / Sambre – o reciprocate current exchanges being arranged

All exchanges to provide notes / minutes to be referenced the virtual resource centre

Other

1. Social Enterprise Academy – possible route for sustainable legacy for G&BF ? TSWT to invite them to the steering group event
2. Action 2 – CRT to review final paragraph of action 2
3. CRT to ask Sambre to prepare a presentation for the steering group meeting in June – so to exchange their experience - Subject : Managing and Personal Development of Beneficiaries – needs analysis for individual employment potential needs
4. CRT to invite Canal Connections to the Steering group meeting to exchange experience – subject – Sustaining Canal Connections – Past and Future
5. West Flanders to produce amendments to the application taking into account changes in Action 6 – swapping between outputs 2 and 4 to reflect current situation
